Because of the unique design of these stapled clogs, the shoes will fit a bit differently than a traditional shoe.

THINK YOUR SHOE MIGHT BE TOO BIG?

Clogs are designed to have up to 1/2 inch of space between the back of the shoe and the heel of your foot. If you can not insert your finger between your heel and the back of the shoe, you should consider trying one size larger. You will need the space behind the heel for comfort while walking.

You'll notice that the sole on these shoes is rigid and does not flex. In order to accommodate the natural motion of the foot when walking and to prevent rubbing on the back of the foot, these clogs are designed to have your heel "slip" up and down when walking.



You will also notice this shoe has a firm heel counter at the back of the shoe and that the back of the shoe does not curve toward your foot. This gives you the space you need for the "slipping" motion (mentioned earlier) while preventing the shoe from rubbing against your foot.



These shoes are also designed with some "wiggle room" in the toe area. Your toes should not feel cramped. The shoe should fit more snugly at the instep and ball of the foot.

STILL UNSURE?

Try wearing these shoes around the house on soft, carpeted surfaces for a few days and adjust to the unique fit and feel of these clogs. Once you're used to them, you, like most of our customers, will find that these may be your favorite shoes.
